

Mexican Whorled Milkweed

Asclepias fascicularis

Category: Perennials

Hardiness: USDA Zone 6-10

Bloom Color: Pale Green
White/Near White clusters

Bloom Time: Mid Summer thru early Fall

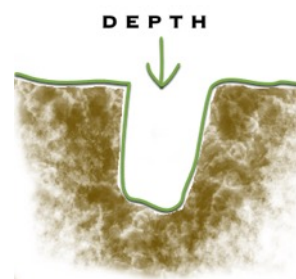
Propagation Methods: Direct sow outdoors in fall. Sow seeds on surface after first frost. Seeds will germinate in late spring. Cold stratification is required for best result.



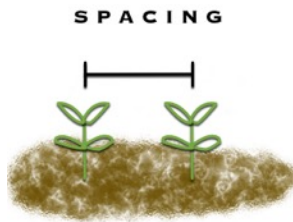
SUN: Full sun



Water: Average. After first year Average to Dry.



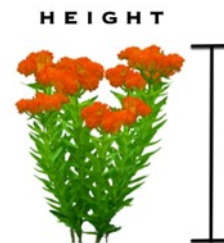
Depth: Cover seed with no more than 1/4 inch of soil.



Spacing: Plant close and thin 1 1/2 to 3 feet between plants, or as needed.



Spread: 1 to 2 feet from main stem. Varies with age increases with plant spread.



Height: 2 to 4 feet. 1 foot is common for first year growth.
